History:

Technological Initiative Pilsen (hereinafter TIP) is an association of legal entities, which was founded in 2012. Case number L 6909 kept by the Regional Court in Pilsen.

The reason for its foundation was to associate entities with significant developmental and technological potential in the Pilsen region in order to enhance mutual cooperation and competitiveness. The Association currently has eighteen members, including major companies of international significance, and other associated partners. The Association has also started a number of interesting projects that focus not only on securing benefits for members or partners, but also on supporting the entire region.

Vision:

An association of technological companies formed on the basis of mutual benefit. The association co-ordinates the workload of highly skilled workers, especially development engineers, development workers and workers. The association helps to optimize the requirements of their work and/or fluctuations in their occupancy and performance. The Association provides a suitable platform for meeting and managing the discussions of individual members. The Association coordinates procedures and promotes common interests. The Association cooperates with the public sector and educational institutions.

Main objectives:

- creation of an environment for cooperation of the Initiative's members in the area of development, science and research,
- creation of an environment for efficient sharing of TIP member resources,
- protection and enforcement of the general and ethic interests of TIP members,
- support for the creation of a positive image for TIP members,
- support for TIP members when maintaining and developing relationships abroad,
- support for TIP members' behavior in conformity with usual business practice, fair competition and good manners,
- joint projects implementation.

Activities in 2016

In 2016 the membership was expanded by addition of 3 new members. This relates namely to the following companies:

- ZF Staňkov s.r.o.
- Eurosoftware s.r.o.
- MBtech Bohemia s.r.o.

In 2016 three general meetings of TIP members were held in total.

On 10 March 2016 a general meeting was organized in the premises of the company ZF Staňkov, where a presentation and visit of the company premises was organized for TIP



members and partners, all participants thus had a possibility to look into the facilities of the top industrial production and draw inspiration for their own operating establishments. At the same time, the company ZF Staňkov was accepted as a regular TIP member. Very interesting guests were the representatives of the University of West Bohemia. A presentation was given by Mr. Vice-Chancellor Ladislav Čepička on the theme of establishing an English school

by the University of West Bohemia and an expert presentation of Mrs. Šárka Houdková of the Research Centre of New Technologies by the University of West Bohemia was focused on the applicability of laser technologies.

On 31 May 2016 TIP together with the Czech-German Chamber of Commerce and Industry (ČNOPK) and the Chamber of Commerce and Industry Regensburg (IHK) organized a

moderated discussion with leaders of political election lists for the office of the regional council president of the Pilsen Region. About thirty general directors of industrial companies constituting a backbone of the Pilsen Region economy used the opportunity to present their expectations from the regional politicians to the attending candidates for the Regional Council President – Josef Bernard for ČSSD, Martin Baxa for ODS and Miloslav Zeman for ANO. The main







topic of the whole afternoon meeting was availability of specialized labor forces in the quickly developing Pilsen Region.

On 9 November 2016 a General Meeting of TIP was held, this time in the premises of the company MBtech Bohemia in Pilsen. At the beginning of the General Meeting the participants were welcomed by the Secretary General Pavel Duchek together with the representative of the company MBtech Mr. Rudolf Vohnout who introduced all activities of the company and even a very interesting visit of the whole establishment was not missing. The



program involved traditionally also a very interesting specialized presentation, this time a presentation given by Mrs. Ludmila Kučerová of the Regional Technical Institute of the West Bohemian University on the topic New Trends and Possibilities in Metallography.

In 2016 TIP has also provided the financial amount of CZK 15,000 to the Endowment Fund "Support of Technical Education in the Pilsen Region", on the basis of a donation agreement. This endowment is intended for support of technical education and increased interest of the pupils of primary and secondary schools in technically focused studies.

Plans for the Next Year 2017

In 2017 the TIP association will continue in common meetings of all members and associate partners, in organizing specialized trainings and the project for support of technical education. The association will inform of these and other events through its website.

The support of technical education is a flagship project and the association intends to continue in its activities. An important issue is the cooperation with regional partners and media, with which some member and partner companies are already establishing regular contacts, articles about all successful projects in this area will be further published in the local media.

TIP wants to further extend its membership and partnership.

In conclusion, I would like to thank all representatives of member and partner companies and organizations for their active participation in our association's activities in 2016. We succeeded, amongst other things, in keeping technical education an issue on the agenda, and we held a number of fascinating specialist debates with our partners.
